

April's Fulfillment Hour Lessons Unit 2: Call to Ministry

These lessons explores the diverse ways in which Jesus' disciples were challenged to exercise their call to ministry by witnessing to the Gospel message, acting with loving kindness, sharing the Resurrection story.

April 7th – "Call and Mission" (Matthew 10:1-15)

- ⇒ **Application:** Matthew 10:1 (MSG) "The prayer was no sooner prayed than it was answered. Jesus called twelve of his followers and sent them into the ripe fields. He gave them power to kick out the evil spirits and to tenderly care for the bruised and hurt lives."
- ⇒ Aim for Change: The disciples who had been with Jesus for some time had touched, talked, shared, communed, prayed, meditated, and fellowshipped with Him. They certainly had witnessed His preaching and teaching and how He went about both. Several lessons can be learned from this.
 - Every believer needs to be with Jesus. We must all learn to quietly meditate and study His Word and commune with Him in prayer.
 - 2) Every servant needs to go through a period of preparation and training before being sent forth.
 - 3) A personal relationship, being with Jesus day by day, is essential for ministry. There is no substitute for the training a person receives at the feet of Jesus studying His Word and learning from His Spirit and communing with Him in prayer.

April 14th – "Called to Remember" (Matthew 26:1-13)

- ⇒ **Application:** Matthew 26:13 (AMP) "Truly I tell you, wherever this good news (the Gospel) is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will be told also, in memory of her."
- ⇒ Aim for Change: Every act of love and faith for Christ is a witness to Christ's death, and the more we sacrifice in giving money and in working, the stronger our witness is to His death. The depth and strength of our belief in His death can be measured by the depth and strength of our sacrifice. The death of Christ would be seen much clearer if we demonstrated stronger love and faith in Him, or to put it another way, if we sacrificed more for Him.

April 21st – "Called to Proclaim the Resurrection" (Matthew 28:1-15)

- ⇒ **Application:** Matthew 28:10 (AMP) "Then Jesus said to them, Do not be alarmed and afraid; go and tell My brethren to go into Galilee, and there they will see Me."
- ⇒ Aim for Change: Believers can become witnesses of the Lord's death and resurrection—clear witnesses. They can see as though they were eyewitnesses—all by God's Spirit.

April 28th – "Call and Commissioning" (Matthew 28:16-20; Acts 1:3-8)

- ⇒ **Application:** Matthew 28:19-20 (AMP) "Go then and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you, and behold, I am with you all the days (perpetually, uniformly, and on every occasion), to the [very] close and consummation of the age."
- ⇒ Aim for Change: What Christ taught and commanded must be studied and studied, to the point of learning and knowing and practicing. The commandments of Christ will be the first things taught. They should be the rule of society. Society deteriorates and crumbles when it neglects the teaching and commandments of Christ.

The Promises of God in Five Translations


Isaiah 41:13 (KJV) – "For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee."
